ADAPT is an initiative of Orange Partnership, a community coalition working to prevent and reduce substance abuse among the youth of Hillsborough & rural Orange County through education, advocacy and environmental change. II/Key Duties

- Oversee Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention Team (ADAPT) youth advocacy program, including but not limited to scheduling weekly meetings with students, liaising with school advisors, and coordinating relevant trainings, activities and recruitment.
- Assist in the development and dissemination of quarterly coalition newsletter.
- Coordinate monthly *Talk It Up!* newspaper column.
- Work with staff to record and disseminate meeting minutes and other communication with coalition members.
- Assist in maintaining current and relevant information on coalition website and social media sites. (Web site maintenance experience helpful but not necessary)
- Assist in the coordination of other coalition activities, based on need and interest.

- Experience working with adolescents in an advisory, support or leadership capacity, required
- Knowledge of adolescent substance abuse prevention, preferred
